## Lucretia's Journey

## Cutting Instructions

Well, let's get started. I have revamped the traditional way these blocks would be pieced to eliminate several seams so if these cutting instructions seem odd just bear with me. It works.

There is a bit of pre-sewing for this class, if you choose to do so, to make your experience more enjoyable and fulfilling. However you will have time to get much of this done in class.

You'll need 6 envelopes or plastic bags labeled Rows $A$ - $\mathbf{D}$ plus one marked Half Square Triangles and the last one labeled Flying Geese.

- Row A -

Cut 4-4 1/2" x $41 / 2$ " squares Dark fabric
Place in the Row A bag.

- Row B -

Bars - Sew together 1 dark 1 7/8" strip to 2 Light 1 7/8"strips so they are light, dark, light. Press to the dark. Make one of these. Now cut them into: 8-4 $1 / 2$ " units. Should measure $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$.

Nine Patch - Sew together 1 Light $17 / 8 "$ strip to 2 dark 1 7/8"strips so they are dark, light, dark. Press to the dark. Make two of these. Now cut them into: $32-1$ 7/8" units.

Next - Sew together 1 dark $17 / 8 "$ strip to 2 Light 1 7/8" strips so they are light, dark, light. Press to the dark. Make one. Now cut them into: $16-1$ 7/8" units.

If you choose to make the Nine Patches before class you will need 16 of them and they should measure $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$. You will have lots of time in class to make them there however.

Place in the Row B bag.

- Row C -

Cut 8-4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares Dark fabric
Cut $2-4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles Dark fabric
Cut and sew together 1 dark $17 / 8 "$ strip to 2 light $17 / 8$ "strips so they are light, dark, light. Press to the dark. Make one of these. Now cut them into: $8-41 / 2 "$ units.
Should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$.
Fill up Row C bag with these units.

- Row D -

One of the units in Row $D$ is the center Square in a Square. For this you need to cut:
$5-61 / 8 " \times 61 / 8 "$ square from Dark fabric
$10-5$ 1/4" 55 1/4' squares from Light fabric
Cut 4-4 $1 / 2 \prime \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles Dark fabric
Place in Bag D!

- Half Square Triangle Bag -

Cut 14 - 5" squares Light fabric
Cut $14-5$ " squares Dark fabric
Place into Bag - 1/2 SQ. Triangle

- Flying Geese -

Cut $16-43 / 49 \times 43 / 4$ " Dark fabric
Cut 8-4 $4 / 4$ " $\times 83 / 4$ " Light fabric
Place in Bag - Flying Geese

- Border -

Cut 8-4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " Light fabric
Cut 4-4 $1 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " Light fabric
Last bag!
